

New features in software version 1.1

NAUTILUS software version 1.1 includes improvements to the arpeggio pattern/step sequencer edit screens, and pop-up displays with information on the RT control knobs and related features.

In addition to these new features, the update includes various improvements and resolutions to specific operational issues.

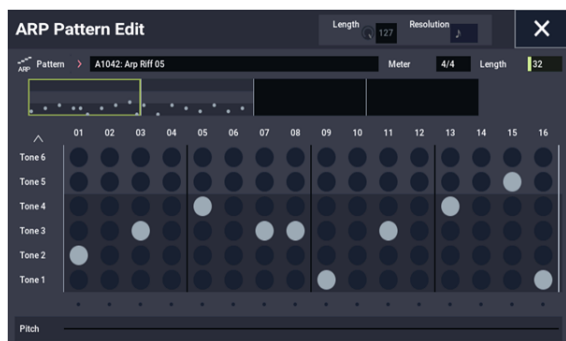
If you're using an older version, you can download the latest software free of charge from the Korg website (<https://shop.korg.com/NAUTILUS/Support>).

We recommend that all NAUTILUS users update to version 1.1. This update may be installed on any KRONOS, regardless of the currently installed system version; it is not necessary to install intermediate upgrades first.

Improvements to the arpeggio pattern edit screen

The layout of the entire screen has been revamped.

- You can now switch between the note input display and the parameter slider operation display.
- The screen has been changed so that you can select the step range from the overview of the edit area, and the tone range from the vertical list of tone names.
- An indicator was added for the playback location.



Improvements to the step sequencer edit screen

The layout of the entire screen has been revamped.

- The screen has been changed so that you can select the step range from the overview of the edit area, and the tone range from the vertical list of tone names.
- An indicator was added for the playback location.
- The playback button now works differently, switching to the edit screen when pressed while the drums are playing.



Drums

The names have been changed that are used in the Inst. List to indicate sounds that may result in an error, as well as the names of indications for sounds other than drums.

!Not Assigned Key: includes drum sounds whose "Assign" setting is off

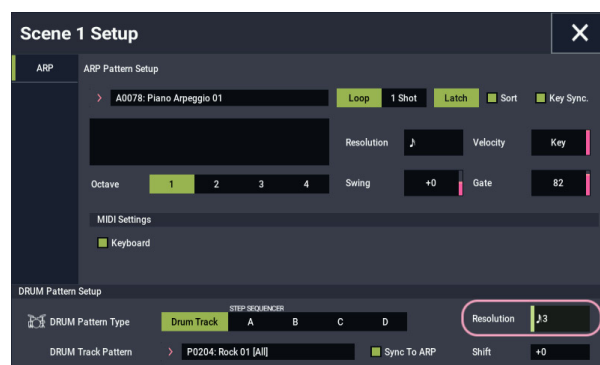
!No Drum Info: indicates that the name data for the drum sound is corrupt

Instrument: indicates an instrument sound other than drums (previously listed as "Not Drum Kit Key" before the update)

Step sequencer

- The "Fixed Note" setting is not loaded when using "Load Arpeggio Pattern" to load an arpeggio pattern. Due to this, the sound you hear may be significantly different, owing to differences between the "Fixed Note" setting of the arpeggio pattern and the "Inst. Key" setting of the step sequencer.

Added "Swing Resolution" parameter for the drum track



Resolution



Use this Resolution parameter to add swing to the rhythm. (Swing for the drum track is controlled with a RT control knob.) The even-numbered notes in the rhythm will shift in time according to the resolution you set.

Added pop-up screens

RT control knob information display

A pop-up information display now appears when the NAUTILUS is in SET LIST, PROGRAM, COMBINATION or SEQUENCER modes and you turn the RT control knobs on the panel to edit a value.

Note: This display is not shown in SAMPLING, GLOBAL or MEDIA mode. (*1)



DYNAMICS knob and button information display

As with the RT control knobs, this information display appears when you change the state of the DYNAMICS knob or button.

Note: This display is not shown in SAMPLING, GLOBAL or MEDIA mode. (*1)

Note: This is not shown on the SET LIST > Edit page. The value you edited is displayed on the slot edit screen.

Octave/Transpose information display

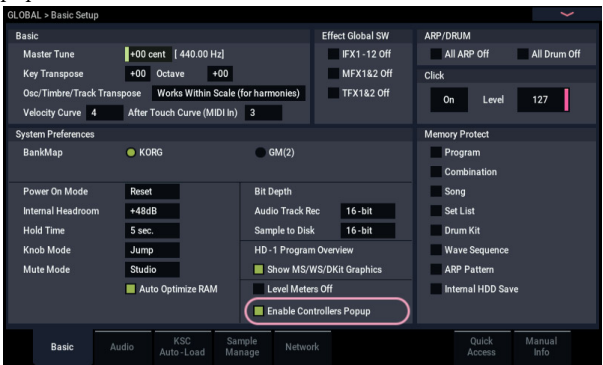
This pop-up display appears in SET LIST, PROGRAM, COMBINATION or SEQUENCER mode after you use the RT control knobs on the panel to edit the Octave or Transpose setting. (*1)

The Octave and Transpose state is shown in the status bar as before, even after the pop-up disappears.



Turning the pop-up display off

To turn the pop-up displays off, deselect the “Enable Controllers Popup” checkbox in GLOBAL > Basic
